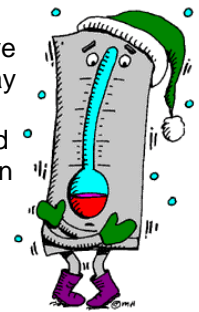
### New Meeting Place
